6. Competitions

June Competitions:

Lady Captain's Day (15th June): This event was very successful. There will be a possible format change next year (see AOB)

Jubilee (29th June): This event was highly successful with the HCGC Ladies winning the Trophy

July Competitions:

Invitation day (6th July): This event eventually took place in the afternoon, following the closure of the course in the morning due to flooding.

20th July Medal: We will be reverting to doing a draw in divisions from this date forward. A rota for ladies doing future draws is required (DvdW)

However, as it is realised that some members may be unhappy mixing in the changing rooms, the draw on the 20th will take place in the clubroom, with members attending outside to enable them to have their golf shoes on ready to play.

Hudson Trophy (24th July): As at the 13th July 9 ladies have signed up, but it is hoped that others will sign up before the closing date of 6th July. This year players will go out in reverse handicap order, commencing 7.54 a.m. This championship competition is being trialled on a Saturday to enable some of our lower handicappers to take part. There will be no meal this year, but just drinks after. The trophy will be presented outside, together with prize vouchers for the gross score winner and runner up and nett score winner and runner up.

August Competitions:

9 hole ladies: It was confirmed that a qualifying competition should be played once a month. In general they will play following the silver and bronze divisions, and organise their own draw amongst themselves. GR agreed to make a chart for all of them indicating their Handicap indexes, course handicaps and playing handicaps, this to be put on their 9 hole board in the changing rooms and updated monthly following their monthly qualifying Stableford (GR)
