



### 1. Maximum of 4 balls allowed.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Tee; 18 holes from 7:30am
- 10<sup>th</sup> Tee; 9 holes from 7:30am
- 2. All tee times to be booked via club V1. Booking opens 18:10 from the 12<sup>th</sup> April.
  - The change from 18:00 to 18:10 should further reduce bandwidth congestion with other clubs. Assistance will be available via our Pro shop.

### 3. Competitions.

- Optional competitions will be introduced for members. Please register with the Pro shop in advance if you wish to enter.
  - Mid week stableford, Saturday and Sunday
  - Sectional competitions, Monday to Friday, (no reserved tee times)
- From the 1<sup>st</sup> May introduction of certain club competitions; e.g. Taylor cup.
- From the 4<sup>th</sup> May; ladies Tuesday mornings reserved for sectional competitions.

## 4. Outside Catering & Bar facilities open.

No. Obtaining a sleeve of practise balls from Rob is an optional service for members.


