Up to you as a team, so get to the club in time to get your card, enter your intent to play and decide your team strategy.

The winner of the individual stableford will win the New Year Trophy, normally presented in January, but without a 2021 winner, so let's play it now. The winning team will get vouchers and an extra little prize and then vouchers for second and third place as usual as in January.
