

HARPENDEN COMMON GOLF CLUB – LADIES SECTION HANDBOOK

REMINGTON PLATE

THIS REPLACES THE ORIGINAL LADIES SECTION/AB's CHRISTMAS EVENT

FORM OF COMPETITION: Texas Scramble

All competitors to be members of the Ladies Section plus Men's Senior Section (MSS).
Maximum numbers 88

WHEN PLAYED: Annually, early December

ENTRANCE FEE:

As stipulated and deducted from Bar Cards the day after the competition (Dec 2017)

DETAILS:

Organised by the Ladies Section with the aid of a male player.

- Each team will consist of four players, 2 male and 2 female. The entrants will be seeded into 4 groups
- Group A - That half of the male entrants with the lowest handicaps
- Group B - The remainder of the male entrants
- Group C - That half of the female entrants with the lowest handicaps
- Group D - The remainder of the female entrants.
- Each team will consist of one player from each group drawn at random
- Draw is done on a 1st come first served basis. If there are any withdrawals, the Competition's Organiser is responsible for allocating reserves.

The MSS Captain and Lady Captain will lead the field, one from 1st and one from 10th, unless drawn together.

The handicap allowance will be 10% of the team total. This must not be rounded up or down. Each player must take a minimum of 3 tee shots. These will be recorded in the marker column on the score card.

In all circumstances other than on the putting green, the ball will be DROPPED as per the RULES OF GOLF. **CHECK REGARDING PREFERRED LIES ON FAIRWAYS.**
