The Competition is played off the ladies' card. Men off yellow tees, ladies off red tees at all times, including the 8<sup>th</sup>. Ladies receive 3 shots.

**PREPARATIONS** are made by the Ladies' Competition Organiser and a representative from MSS.

A signing up list goes up on respective notice boards (Ladies & MSS) approximately 5 weeks in advance

MSS's Representative meets with the Ladies' Competition's Organiser approximately 7 days before the fixture to complete the draw. Husbands and wives do not play together. Names are re-drawn if necessary. Husbands & Wives are given similar tee times to assist with travel arrangements.

The Lady Captain and MSS Captain lead the field. The Lady Vice Captain is included in the draw.

An identical drawn list with names and times go up in the ladies' and men's changing rooms. Once equal numbers are achieved any other signees will be held as reserves. Draw is done on a 1<sup>st</sup> come first served basis. If there are any withdrawals, the competition's organiser is responsible for allocating reserves.

• Ladies head up the cards.

All play off the 1<sup>st</sup> Tee starting at 8.30 am. MSS are responsible for booking the tee times, locating the Trophy and organising the prize- giving after play.
