Hopefully you will have seen an email from the Manager's office, regarding the Trolley suspension. If not, I have included below the relevant excerpt outlining the exception he has put in place. Please contact Craig direct if you wish to discuss this further: -

"The dry weather over the last week has significantly reduced the risk in the use of a trolley, I would therefore now like to extend an exception to those members that have been unable play because of the necessity to carry their clubs.

Members who are unable to carry and wish to play please come to the office where we will issue a pink tag. Those members with a pink tag will be able to use a trolley on the course from Monday 24<sup>th</sup> January. Please note trollies must not be taken inside the roped off areas.

For members without a pink tag the trolley suspension remains in place till further notice. "

**As most of the Ladies section will still be carrying, the restriction on the number of clubs to a maximum of 6 (including putter) will remain in place for all Ladies' competitions until further notice. You are free to carry as many clubs as you wish at other times.**
