We had a lot of varied discussions yesterday about carrying your bag and how many clubs you are allowed to carry.

It states in the Ladies Handbook (Page 80), under the heading **TROLLEY BAN**,
“When ladies are required to carry their clubs on the course, it is requested that all ladies, including those using trollies with an agreed concession, **play with a maximum of SIX clubs (including a putter)**”
This applies to Tuesday/Saturday competitions, to make it fair to all those ladies taking part in the competition. We have no more qualifiers this year.

This does not apply, but it is expected that players come to an amicable agreement should some be carrying and others not, with casual golf, or KO competitions.

This rule will be discussed at the next committee meeting, so watch out for any updates.

I have been asked to remind you that when you fix dates for your KO competitions, then always arrange a reserve date with each other as the possibility of bad weather, and/or course closure at this time of the year, is very high.
