**STROKE ALLOWANCES**

The following outlines the WHS regulations regarding handicap allowances in competition play, which must be applied for the undernoted forms of competition when played as handicap events.

<b>Individual Stroke Play, Stableford, Par/Bogey, Maximum Score</b>	<b>95%</b>
<b>Fourball Stroke Play</b>	<b>85%</b>
<b>Fourball Stableford</b>	<b>85%</b>
<b>Fourball Par/Bogey</b>	<b>90%</b>
<b>Individual Match Play</b>	<b>100%</b>
<b>Fourball Match Play</b>	<b>90%</b>
<b>Greensomes</b>	<b>60% low handicap + 40% high handicap</b>
<b>Best 1 of 4 Stroke Play</b>	<b>75%</b>
<b>Best 2 of 4 Stroke Play</b>	<b>85%</b>
<b>Best 3 of 4 Stroke Play</b>	<b>100%</b>
<b>Best 4 of 4 Stroke Play</b>	<b>100%</b>
<b>Scramble (4 players)</b>	<b>25%/20%/15%/10% from lowest to highest handicap</b>
<b>Scramble (2 players)</b>	<b>35% low/15% high</b>
<b>Total score of 2 Match Play</b>	<b>100%</b>
<b>Best 1 of 4 Par/Bogey</b>	<b>75%</b>
<b>Best 2 of 4 Par/Bogey</b>	<b>80%</b>
<b>Best 3 of 4 Par/Bogey</b>	<b>90%</b>
<b>4 of 4 Par/Bogey</b>	<b>100%</b>

These handicap allowances will only count as part of playing handicaps. They will not, for example, have any bearing on the acceptable score you return as part of your best eight of 20 cards under the new global handicap system.
