RULES AND GUIDANCE FOR KNOCKOUT COMPETITIONS

- 1. Please pay your entry fee when you sign up for the Knockout Competition.
- 2. The person/s whose name is at the top of the list is responsible for proposing suitable match dates.
- 3. At least 3 dates should be offered, and one MUST be a weekday.
- 4. One of the dates must be offered within the FIRST 3 WEEKS of the beginning of the round.
- 5. If after agreement of the date of the match, one player cannot for any reason play, they must give their opponents a "walk over".
 - NB. In the case of the Summer Knock Out (4BBB) then the remaining partner may play alone.
- 6. In a doubles Knock Out Competition, if a partner drops out BEFORE the first round, a new partner can be selected, as long as that person has not played in any round of the same competition.
- 7. The ONLY EXTENSION for any match is the number of days on which the course is closed.
- 8. Where a suitable date for players cannot be agreed in the required time period the players should refer to the Lady Captain and Competitions Secretary for guidance.
- 9. The playing of Knock Out matches on a Tuesday is only allowable at the discretion of the Lady Captain, and only after the ladies have completed the first nine holes to avoid using booked tee times.
- 10. The finals of any Knockout Competition, will be refereed by a club member, chosen by the Lady Captain.
- 11. Entry Criteria:

Summer and Winter Knock outs – maximum 42.4 handicap Burley/Lambert – Maximum 42.4 Ginny St John Glew – no maximum handicap
