

HARPENDEN COMMON GOLF CLUB – LADIES SECTION HANDBOOK

TEXAS SCRAMBLE

PLAYED IN THREES OR FOURS

All players drive then choose the ball in the best position.

Mark it with a tee peg within 6 inches.

The owner of that ball then plays her second shot.

The other players then drop their ball within a club length of the marker, no nearer the hole, from where they play their second shot. If the original ball is on the green, then subsequent balls must be placed and puttied from the same spot.

Repeat this process with every shot.

Once a ball has been holed that completes the hole, so DO NOT tap in if another player has a chance to hole a putt.

The score is recorded as a gross score for each hole.

- Each player must have their drive used.
- Three players - five times in the round.
- Four players - four times in the round.

The card must be marked in some way to indicate which person's drive was used on each hole.

At the completion of the game, total the score and deduct:

- Three players - 1/6th of combined handicaps.
- Four players - 1/10th of combined handicaps.

Playing handicap:	(4 players)	25%, 20%, 15%, 10% From lowest to highest
	(3 players)	30%, 20%, 10% From lowest to highest
	(2 players)	35% low, 15% high

9 Hole Competition played on 1/12th of combined handicap. Each player must have 2 drives in 3 or 4 player competition.
