REMINGTON PLATE

FORM OF COMPETITION:

• Texas Scramble - Strokeplay

All competitors to be members of the Ladies Section plus Men's Senior Section (MSS). Maximum number 88.

WHEN PLAYED: Annually, early December.

ENTRANCE FEE: As stipulated and deducted from Bar Cards the day after the competition.

DETAILS: Organised by the Ladies Section with the aid of a male player.

Each team will consist of 4 players, 2 male and 2 female, seeded into 4 groups: Men off Yellow Tees, Ladies off Red Tees.

- Group A that half of the male entrants with the lowest handicaps
- Group B the remainder of the male entrants
- Group C that half of the female entrants with the lowest handicaps
- Group D the remainder of the female entrants

Each team will consist of one player from each group attempting to balance handicaps across each team. Entry is on a 1st come 1st served basis. If there are any withdrawals, the Competition Organiser is responsible for allocating reserves. Once the draw has been undertaken, any late entries will be treated as reserves.

The Men's Seniors Captain and the Lady Captain will lead the field, one from the 1st tee and one from the 10th, unless drawn together.

The handicap allowance will be calculated in accordance with the WHS.

Each player must take a minimum of 3 tee shots, to be recorded in the marker column on the scorecard. The team member whose shot is selected, will play their shot first.

- Fairway or apron each team member may place a ball within 6 inches of either side of the selected shot, no nearer the hole.
- Putting green each team member may place a ball within 4 inches of either side of the selected shot, no nearer the hole.
- In all other circumstances the ball will be dropped in accordance with the rules of golf.

Where someone drops out of a team and a reserve is not available, the remaining players may play in their allocated tee time but will not be included in the competition.
